Feedback Area	Description	Decision
Defence Chaplaincy	It was noted that key differences between this qualification and the requirements of the wider Chaplaincy sector is that more broadly Chaplains are not necessarily ordained ministers as they are in Defence. If there is a requirement for them to act as Christian Chaplains is there is the need for theology training to be part of the qualification.	The requirement to hold a Bachelor of Theology is a Defence recruitment and capability requirement, and not a requirement underpinning this qualification.

Additional comments

Much of the material in the DEF Defence Training Package Release 3.0 Draft materials were sensitive and not available for review without prior written consent from Defence. Material that was not sensitive and suitable for public review was prominent on the AIS website project page for sector-wide consultation from 9 April to 27 April 2020 and again from 11 May to 5 June 2020. Stakeholders were invited to review the draft material and provide comment during those periods.
