## Qualification Description

This qualification is suitable for people who work in the maritime industry as:

- Chief Integrated Rating

### Licensing and/Regulatory information

- This qualification forms some of the requirements for certification by the Australian Maritime Safety Authority (AMSA) as a Chief Integrated Rating as defined in Marine Orders.

This qualification is required to obtain AMSA certificate of competency as a Chief Integrated Rating as defined in Marine Orders.

AMSA certification of competency will require:

- completing an approved program of study appropriate for the grade of certificate (Certificate IV in Maritime Operations Chief Integrated Rating)
- holding a certificate of competency as defined in Marine Order 73
- qualifying sea service as defined in Marine Order 73
- completing STCW short courses as defined in Marine Order 73
- holding a valid AMSA certificate of medical fitness
- meeting any other regulatory requirements as defined in Marine Order 73

Seafarers seeking certification should check requirements with AMSA.
