Current Training Package Updates

Defence Geospatial skills

- The following materials to be submitted to AISC for consideration no later than May- 4 new Units of Competency, 2 new Skill Sets, Defence Case for Endorsement, CVIG.

Police Training

- The Advanced Police Supervision qualifications have been approved by the AISC for release on the National Register.

Public Safety

- The Fire TAC has 69 Units submitted to AISC, with only 4 remaining.
- The Public Safety TAC has 63 Units to transition and review, with 29 completed. Units of Competency to complete include- 3 x Comm's, 8 x M'gmt, 11x Facility Emergency Response and 9x Operational

Other Business

- The IRC discussed and addressed a collated list of issues/concerns received during the consultations period.

IRC Skills Forecast update

- AIS provided an overview of the current Skills Forecast and the information that will be required to produce the 2018 edition. AIS has been collecting data and collating information for the next Skills Forecast. AIS requested that any relevant industry reports or information on emerging trends be forwarded via the Industry Manager for consideration. The IRC considered priorities for the Proposed Schedule of Work.
