### **Current Training Package Updates**

- TAC is continuing development work on the Certificate IV Work Rescue Ground Flight and RPAS new Qualification.
- The Remote Pilot License Aircraft systems (RPAS) has been given an extension due to the significant workload (6 TAC cycles) and completion date is now April 2019
- AVI20118 Certificate II in Transport Security Protection Qualifications have identified four key areas; air, cargo, domestic and maritime. Accreditation is underway and will be completed shortly
- IRC discussed removal of superfluous qualifications and Units with zero enrolments over the last 3 years.

### **Skills Forum**

AIS will conduct several Skills Forums nationally to broaden stakeholder consultation.
The Forums will provide an opportunity for stakeholders to engage and make a real
contribution at the ground level and the Forums will be a central platform for this year's
intelligence gathering for the 2019 Skills Forecast. IRC members were informed of dates
and locations and encouraged to participate in the forums.
