- A workshop was organized for 27-28 February targeting specific transition issues that need addressing

will be required to produce the 2019 edition. AIS has been collecting data and
collating information for the next Skills Forecast. AIS requested that any relevant
industry reports or information on emerging trends be forwarded via the Industry
