Current Training Package Updates

- IRC discussed methods of attracting the most appropriate members to join TAC's as subject matter experts.
- The Chair encouraged members to support the Supply Chain Cross-sector project which touches on 35 IRC's with T&L being a key component
- The need for a Skill Set for contractors working around underground fuel storage was identified
- The NAT Roads Apprenticeship proposal was discussed, and it was agreed not to advance the proposal at this stage. IRC commended NAT Roads on the submission and that an ongoing discussion to alleviate the driver shortage and broaden appeal to school leavers is needed.

IRC Skills Forecast update

- AIS provided a draft of the 2019 Skills Forecast. AIS has been collecting data and collating information over the last year and thanked IRC members for forwarding relevant industry reports and information on emerging trends. Discussion was held around items to be included in the Proposed Schedule of Work. Feedback from IRC members will close on 18 Feb with the draft planned for release to broader stakeholder network on 15 March

Meeting Outcomes

- IRC to provide AIS with feedback on Skills Forecast by 18 February
- NAT Roads proposal discussed and not proceeding at this stage
- Skill Set for fuel storage contractors identified
