Current Training Package Updates

- IRC provided an update on the Corrections Training Package; Cultural Competence developed three units and associated Units of Competency (UoC)- Protect Safety Welfare is out for public consultation, Provide Support to Offenders is finished and out for public consultation, the feedback will be collated by the Technical Advisor Committee (TAC), and Work effectively with culturally diverse offenders and colleagues which closed consultation on 27 February
- Electronic Monitoring and Surveillance new Skills Sets developed and out for public consultation
- Immigration Detention eight core units and eight electives out for public consultation.
- Youth Custodial and Youth Community units are out for public consultation
- Youth Justice revision of one qualification and associate UoC
- AIS provided Water Skills Forum feedback to the IRC for consideration for inclusion into the Skills Forecast

IRC Skills Forecast Update

- AIS provided a draft of the 2019 Skills Forecast. AIS has been collecting data and collating information over the last year and thanked IRC members for forwarding relevant industry reports and information on emerging trends. Discussion was held around items to be included in the Proposed Schedule of Work. Feedback from IRC members will close on 5 March with the draft planned for release to broader stakeholder network on 15 March.
