Current Training Package Updates

- IRC discussed the scale of the work required. The focus is on completing the transition and review 55 Units of Competency and address issues that require attention.

- IRC agreed to add Electricity Supply Industry Statement for every unit to specify that it belongs to the electricity Industry.
- IRC discussed the importance of filling the vacancy for a representative from renewables as part of the IRC and will follow up as a priority.
- IRC to provide a glossary of terms used by the Energy Networks Australia.
- IRC agreed to move the Range of Statement to the Companion Volume (CVIG) unless it is reported by exception by application.
- AIS provided ESI TDR Skills Forum feedback to the IRC for consideration for inclusion into the Skills Forecast

IRC Skills Forecast update

AIS provided a draft of the 2019 Skills Forecast. AIS has been collecting data and collating
information over the last year and thanked IRC members for forwarding relevant

March.
