Industry and VET updates

- VET updates were provided to the IRC and members discussed the possible direction of the VET arrangements and the future of VET post the review.
- The IRC discussed a letter sent by the Royal Commission to all IRC Chairs regarding Child Sex Abuse and the survey.
- Cross Sector Protocols- The IRC were presented with a draft of the IRC Operating Protocols to include Cross-sector Projects and the role of SSOs and IRCs

2019-2023 IRC Skills Forecast

- The IRC were presented with the briefing notes provided by AIS on current issues and opportunities for discussion
- It was explained to the IRC that there will no longer be an annual Skills Forecast, but AIS will still work with the IRC to complete a Skills Outlook.

Other Business

- There are several industry events coming up where there will be opportunities to promote VET. ANZPAA will have a conference in March 2020 and recommended AIS Should have a booth as it did this year.
