Current Training Package Updates

- Update was provided on the Cross-sector project. In summary there are 13 new Units of Competency, 9 revised Units, 10 new Skill Sets, potential deletion of five existing units
- Chain of Responsibility has developed two new units to replace three old units;
 - TLIF0001X Ensure the safety of transport activities (Chain of Responsibility)
 - TLIF0002X Monitor the safety of transport activities (Chain of Responsibility)
- The Diploma of International Freight Forwarding is at the point of undergoing QA edit
- The “Traffic Operations” qualification has been renamed to Traffic Control Room Operations incorporating two streams- Open Road and Tunnel
- The Certificate III Supply Chain is currently with the QA editor
- The TAC has re-written 23 Units of Competency for Stevedore qualifications and will be ready for release later this year
- Heavy vehicle driver safety public consultation has completed. 25 Units and six Skill Sets have been reviewed.
- IRC discussed the PWC proposal to incorporate five new Units of Competency relating to naval shipbuilding logistics’ skills into the TLI Training.

- The IRC discussed the new Cert IV Transport Scheduling qualification and the need to get RTO’s to put it on their scope of delivery for uptake
